MOUNGA REO PROGRAMME 2023

Taranaki Iwi are pleased to respond to a tono from our uri to promote and support our reo Māori aspirations. This programme is based on Taranaki Iwi kōrero and will be run in conjunction with Te Ataarangi ki te Kāhui Maunga and their competent team of kaiako.

This is one of three current projects connected to [Ataraweia](#) who will host the Moodle based Learning Management System (LMS).

Mounga Reo is a course to strengthen reo proficiency in formal and informal settings. The course will offer two levels - Taumata 1 (moderate basic level of reo) and Taumata 2 (proficient/advanced level of reo) and is open for up to 150 participants.

The course will run for 10 weeks, virtually via Zoom commencing on **Thursday 31 August 2023 from 6pm - 7.30pm for Level 1 and 7.30pm - 9pm for Level 2 and conclude on Thursday 2 November 2023.**

To ensure you do not miss out (as many uri did in 2022), **you must register and commit to the 10 week programme.** The weekly sessions are carefully planned and your commitment for the full 10 weeks is paramount to the continuation of Mounga Reo beyond 2023.

Eligibility criteria:

- Must be registered with Taranaki Iwi
- Must be **committed** to the **full 10 week programme** and agree with the expectations set at the start of the course
- Removal from the programme will occur when consecutive classes are missed
- Must participate in survey(s)
